PENTECOST 50 DAY PRAYER AND FASTING

P-50 D-P&F

INTRODUCTION

Pentecost 50 Day Prayer and Fasting (*P-50 D-P&F*) is a time to ask the Lord through His Holy Spirit to bring about Revival. It starts on Resurrection Sunday and ends on Pentecost Sunday. Let us commit to call on the Lord and fast everyday for 50 days to bring about revival.

ABOUT FASTING

WHY FAST?

- Fasting was an expected discipline in the Old and New Testament eras. Moses fasted. Jesus fasted 40 days and reminded His followers to fast (Matt. 6:16–18).
- Fasting and prayer will create a more intimate relationship with Christ.
- Fasting is a biblical way to truly humble yourself in the sight of God (Psalm 35:13; Ezra 8:21). King David said, "I humble myself through fasting."
- Fasting enables the Holy Spirit to reveal your true spiritual condition, resulting in brokenness, repentance, and a transformed life.
- Fasting can result in a dynamic personal revival in your own life—and make you a channel of revival to others.

HOW TO FAST SAFELY

As important as fasting is, you should always make sure you do not put your health at risk. Please consult your Doctor first if you want to pursue a fast, especially for longer periods. Do not skip meals if you need to take medication. God knows your heart.

HOW LONG AND WHAT TYPE OF FAST IS RIGHT FOR YOU?

John Wesley, the founder of the Methodist denomination, fasted every Wednesday and Friday and required all of his clergy to do the same. Effective ministers of God like the apostle Paul, Martin Luther, to John Calvin made it a continual part of their walk with God. Fasting is about the condition of the heart, not the number of days.

People often think the only fast is to go without food or drink for the entire period. This, however, is incorrect as there are other ways in which one can fast, particularly for those who are unable to go without food due to health conditions. A partial fast is described in the book of Daniel. Although the water fast seemed to be the custom of the prophet, there was a three-week period in which he only abstained from "delicacies," meat, and wine (Daniel 10:3). You decide what you can safely go without as a type of fast.

You may want to give up one thing for a day, two days or a week, so it is between you and the Lord. You decide what you can safely give up for this time. You may also want to fast for a few days but keep praying for the whole 50 days. Receiving God's blessing from a fast requires commitment. Arranging time each day with God is crucial in maintaining intimate communion with the Father. Be aware that Satan will do anything to pull you away from your Bible reading and prayer time. When you feel the enemy trying to discourage you, immediately go to God in prayer and ask Him to strengthen your resolve in the face of difficulties and temptations.

HOW TO FINISH IN A HEALTHY WAY

All the experts agree that "breaking the fast" is the critical phase of fasting. Solid food must be re-introduced very slowly. After a 50-day fast, you should make a careful transition for a few days before returning to eating meat or fats or normal foods.

May God bless you in whatever type of fast you decide to follow.

HOW TO USE THE "P-50 D-P&F"

BE COMPLETELY FOCUSED ON THE THEME FOR EACH DAY AND PRAYER SESSION

Prayer is absolutely fantastic! God answers prayer! God loves it when we spend time in prayer with Him! As true as these statements are, prayer can be very challenging and hard at times! Our minds can become distracted, other thoughts flood in, other prayer items come to mind, and sometimes we move away from what we want to pray for. Often God can urge you to pray for something else and we never want to stand in God's way when He leads us to pray for something else. Maybe write them down and come back to them. This will allow you to stay focussed on your current daily prayer session.

PREPARATION TIME

Use this time well and allow the Holy Spirit to draw you closer into the presence of God. Take this preparation time to glorify and praise Him for who He is. Bless Him because He is Lord. Lay your life before Him and confess your sin and failures before Him. Open your heart and mind to receive from the Lord. Draw near to God in quietness and take time to say nothing and just be still.

SCRIPTURE FOR REFLECTION AND MEDITATION

During the time of being still before God, reflect and meditate on the Scriptures provided. Enjoy the closeness of the Lord's presence. Listen to the Lord – He will speak!

ASKING GOD

This is a time for you to speak to God. This section covers certain prayer points as areas of concern and focus but it is not a comprehensive list. This will give you a starting or reference point for your time of intercession. Allow the Holy Spirit to lead you into other related areas for you to pray into. Make a concerted effort to always personalize your prayer time. Furthermore, always try to pray for people by name – remember, be specific.

BE THANKFUL

During this time, you want to show your thankfulness to the Lord. God listens and God answers! He will always answer according to His will. Let us never forget to say thank you to the Lord!

ACTION

This is an opportunity for you to decide what action you need to take. After spending time with the Lord in prayer and in His Word – there will often be something that you need to do. This can often be deeply personal and even hard to do. Be bold, obedient and TAKE ACTION!
